Centralized C2 of air and space forces under a single airman is a fundamental principle of air and space doctrine." (AFDD 1)

	505th Exercise Control Squadron	TERM	The 505 ECS conducts BLUE FLAG and other exercises to provide component, joint, and combined air operations center training emphasizing real-world plans, procedures and C4I equipment. To view the AFMSRR resource, click here.
	6 DOF	TERM	Refers to the number of simultaneous directions or inputs a sensor can measure. Typically used to describe the combination of spatial positions (X, Y, Z) and orientation (roll, pitch, yaw). (DSMC 1992-93 Military Research Fellows Report (reference (a)))
	Absorbing Markov Chain Model	TERM	A Markov chain model that has at least one absorbing state and in which from every state it is possible to get to at least one absorbing state. (DIS Glossary of M&S Terms, and IEEE STD 610.3, (references (b) and (c)))

AC-130U Battle Management Center	The AC-130U BMC is the first ever full mission training device for the AC-130 Gunship.
AC-130U Weapons System Trainer	The WST is a six degree of freedom motion based training device that provides initial, upgrade, re-qualification, and refresher training for AC-130U Gunship Aircrew members.
ACM, ALCM, CALCM Cruise Missile Flight	A free flight simulator for the ALCM/CALCM cruise missile.
Air Defense System Integrator (actual)	ADSI shows integrated space, air and ground data by converting tactical and intelligence datalink information and displaying and forwarding it. ADSI receives, processes, correlates, and displays up to 2000 tracks from various sources.
Airspace Control and Operations Trainer	ASCOT is a full function C4I exercise generation tool. All entity types are supported with realistic emulation of maneuver capabilities, emission generation and detection, weapons employment and data links in live, virtual or constructive environments.
AWACS Mission Training Center (MTC)	AWACS MTC is owned, operated and maintained by PLEXSYS Interface Products, Inc. Provides AWACS Mission Crews state-of-the-art aircrew training device with interactive local and distributive mission long-haul training environments.
B-1 Training System Support Center	The Training System Support Center (TSSC) provides the computational resources necessary to support software and data changes to the B-1 WST, MT, and CPT.
B-2 Weapon System Trainer	The B-2 training system includes the training devices, software, courseware, academic materials, and support elements necessary to train B-2 aircrews, and maintenance personnel, and to keep the configuration of the system current with the aircraft.
Battle Control System - Tyndall Training System	Consoles simulate TDF weapons position operator consoles capable of integrated, combined, DIS and Live modes of operation. Allows playback of student performance. External interface with all SEADS radar/GATR sites.
Combat Electronic Environment Simulator	Used as a threat generation tool.
Communication Effects Simulator	Using the OPNET/Joint Communications Simulation System (JCSS)/NETWARS models, the CES provides a comprehensive graphical user interface (GUI) environment of communications effects on networks. 
